Alcohol Support Service

Fordneuk provides a Housing Support and Care at Home Service for people with a history of alcohol misuse.

Our service

We support up to 42 individuals who are homeless and who may be unwilling or unable to engage with services on a planned or consistent basis. Our service does not need individuals to abstain from alcohol nor to agree to a programme of harm reduction.

Our team

We have an experienced Health and Wellbeing team to support people in the service as well as administration and catering staff.



Positive outcomes

We provide support to help individuals with:

- motivation and taking responsibility
- self-care and living skills
- managing money
- social networks and relationships
- alcohol misuse
- physical health
- emotional and mental health
- meaningful use of time
- managing tenancy and accommodation
- offending.

Individuals being referred should meet the following criteria:

- homeless or at risk of becoming homeless
- alcohol dependent
- history of non-engagement.

All referrals should include the named Care Manager.

All referrals should firstly be sent to the Service Commissioning Officer Ellen McPhilemy. Ellen will advise if the referral is suitable and then forward to our Health and Wellbeing Team.

If a referral is suitable, a Health and Wellbeing Team Leader will contact the relevant Care Manager to arrange a service visit followed by a pre-planning meeting. If everyone agrees the service is suitable, a Health and Wellbeing Team Leader and Senior Housing Administrator will arrange a move-in date.
